PROGRAM OBJECTIVE

To provide a path for Komatsu Dealers to send technicians through 9 Komatsu-specific classes in a short amount of time. Komatsu will provide certification. This eliminates Dealer internal trainee programs for new technicians from local technical colleges, the military, etc.

Technician Eligibility

Technicians must meet one of the following:

- Recent graduate from an accredited Technical College Diesel Program. An official transcript will be required to be submitted.
- Mid-career hire with five or more years of experience as a heavy-duty diesel technician with a recognized equipment manufacturer. (Cat, John Deere, Volvo, Case, etc.)
- Transitioning military with appropriate experience in hydraulics, electrical, mobile equipment maintenance, etc.

Note: The Fast-Track program will not replace the OSUIT Komatsu ACT 2-year program.

Technician Requirements

- •Be fully sponsored by a Komatsu Dealership and be a full-time employee.
- •Sponsoring Dealer responsible for Fast Track Program cost.
- •Sponsoring Dealer provides full pay & and benefits for the duration of the program.
- •Sponsoring Dealer provides laptop, PPE, etc.
- Possess a clean, valid driver's license and pass applicable pre-employment screenings.
- •Have the appropriate tool set prior to the start of the program. The equivalent of the toolset required for the Komatsu ACT Program.
- •Complete Komatsu Foundation and Advanced classes prior to registering for the program.

WPI will provide the following:

- Technician wages and benefits while attending classes at OSUIT
- Tuition
- Dorm Rooms
- Meal Plan
- Travel expenses to and from OSUIT
- Hotel, meals, car rental etc. for trip to Cartersville GA
